The Buckley Amendment and the Sign-in Registration Form:

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, known as the "Buckley Amendment," 20 U.S.C. §123g, as amended, gives a student the right to inspect and review his/her file and, with exceptions, to control the disclosure of the file's contents without the student's express consent. The Act treats "directory information" differently, however; it permits the school to make this information public* unless the student informs the school that part or all the information is not to be released without his/her consent.

Accordingly, as students fill out this registration form, we are asking you to indicate whether you want the law school to bar the release of part or all of the information being collected on the form. If you have any questions see "Student Records (Buckley Amendment)" in the Student Handbook or the Dean's Office.

*Including to outsiders as well as to student organizations and other students; however, the law school has adopted a policy of restricting the directory information it discloses to the public.

Blocking of Computer Information on the Rutgers Computer Network

The following concerns information which is on the Rutgers University Computer Network.

Directory Information

The information (your address and telephone number) that you provide on the Sign-in Registration Form with each semester's registration material is for internal law school use only. However, you should be aware that directory information is also available on the Rutgers Info System and thus is available to users of the Internet both inside and outside the University. (This directory information is drawn from the information on your initial application form.) You have the ability to block public access to this information.
